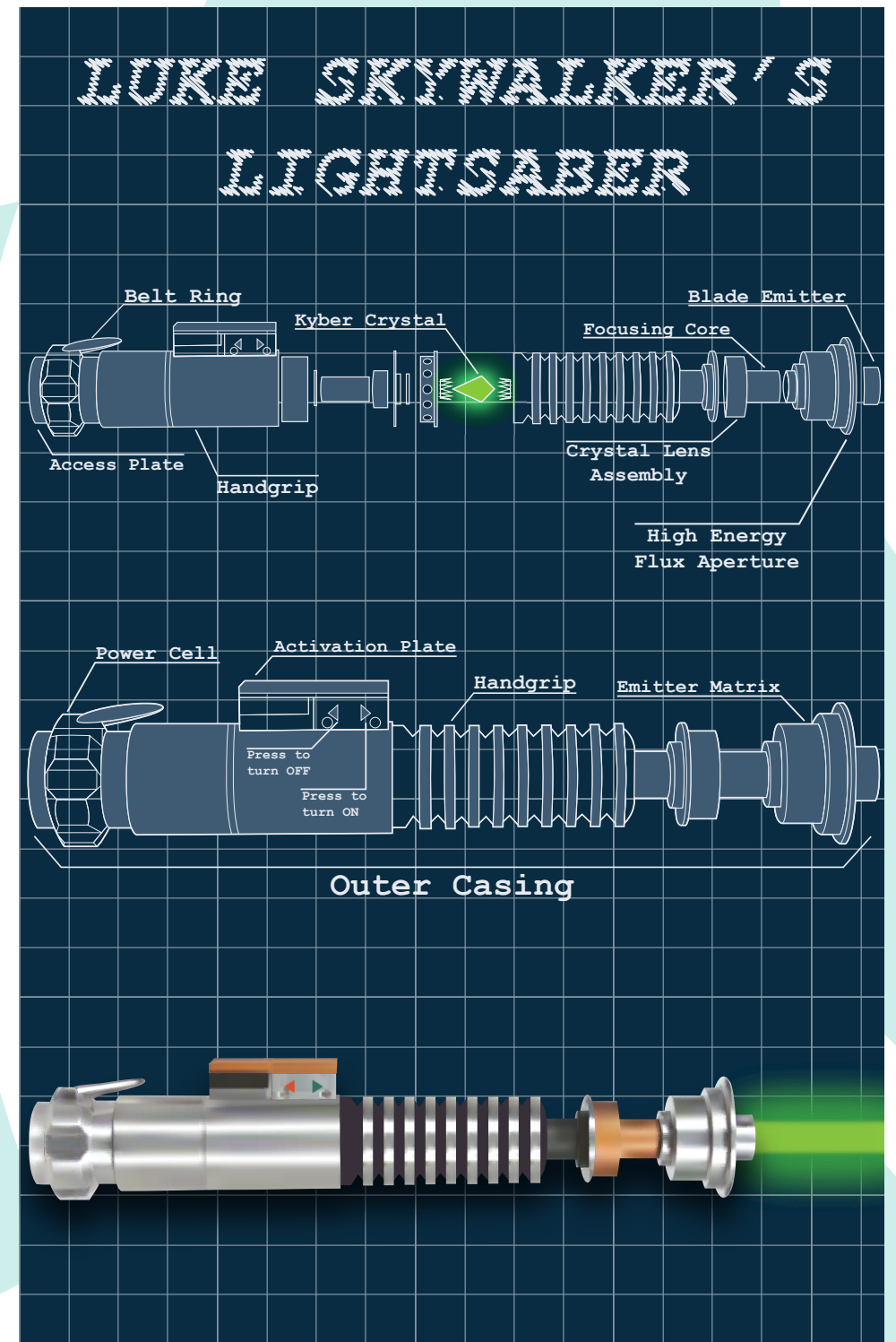


Blueprint

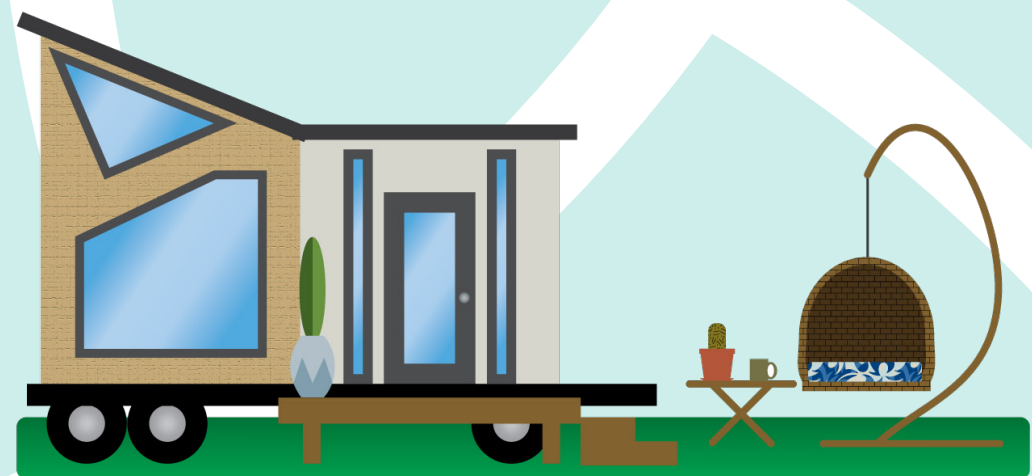
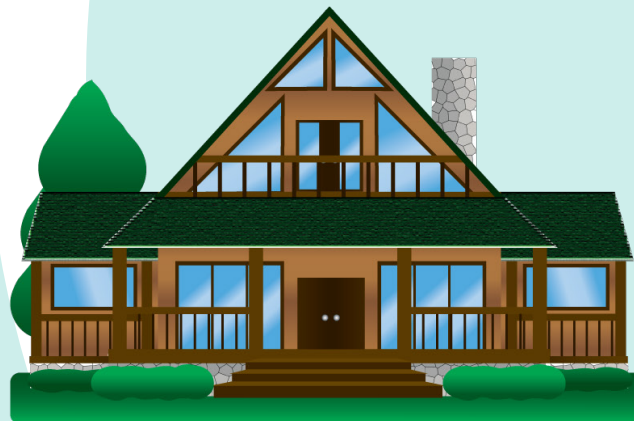

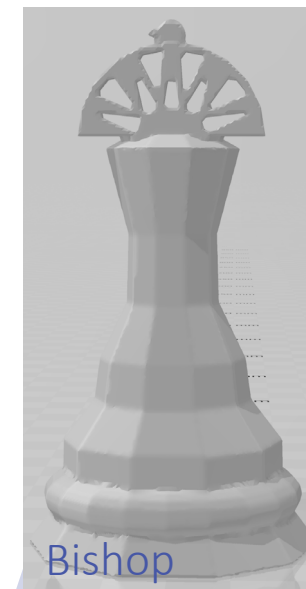

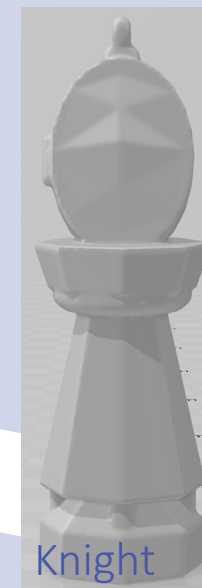
